Your Train

Class 108 units were introduced by British Railways between 1959 and 1962. Built with aluminium frames, roofs, sides and steel cabs, they were classified as 'lightweight' vehicles. With this method of construction, they were relatively corrosion resistant and enjoyed a good power to weight ratio. These diesel multiple units, or DMUs for short, have their engines slung underneath the coach floor. The power cars weigh in at 28 tons with the trailer cars a lighter 22 tons each. Each power car has a pair of 150 horsepower Leyland diesel engines providing the driver with ample energy to move his five car, 128 ton train.

All of the vehicles in this train are typical of those used in the geographical area south west of Birmingham, including the Severn Valley.

Access for the less able

Our diesel unit now has the facility for the carriage of wheelchair users who may access the vehicle using a platform ramp.
