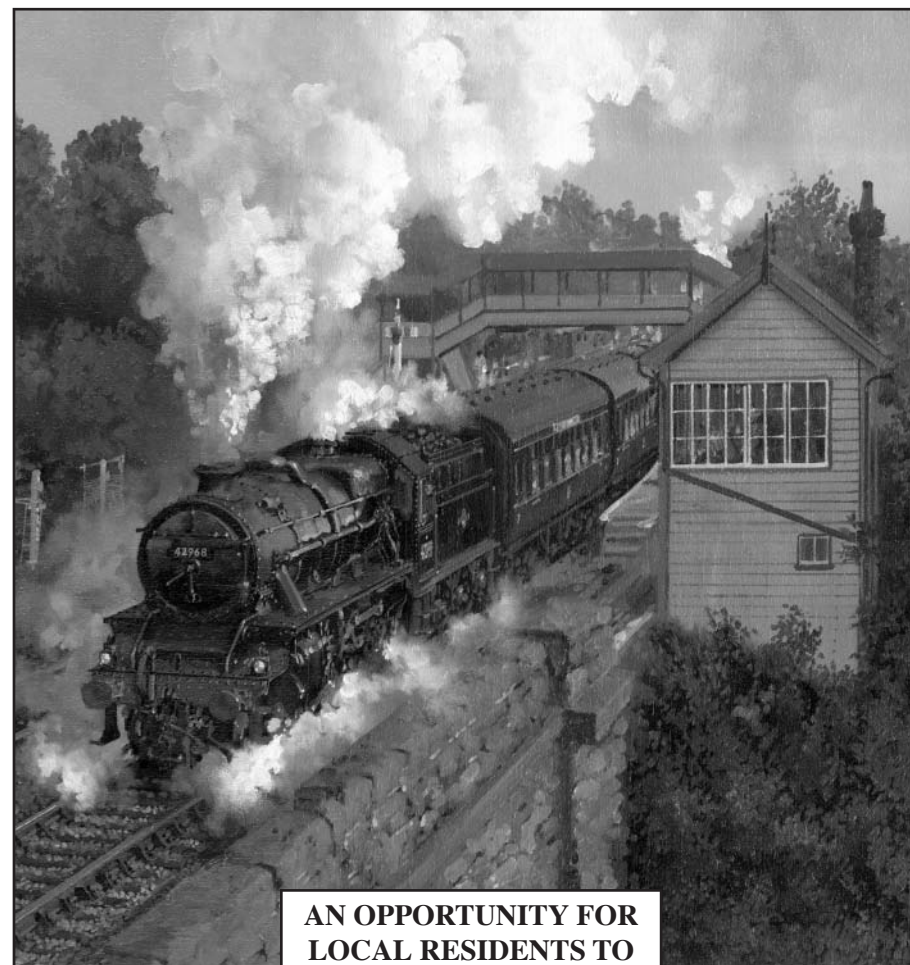

## Local Residents Railcard

Our Local Residents Railcard permits half price rail travel between Kidderminster, Bewdley and Bridgnorth on the Severn Valley Railway for up to two adults travelling together. It also permits concessionary admission to The Engine House, our Visitor Centre at Highley, where applicable.

Enjoy a day walking along the banks of the River Severn, returning by train. Go shopping in Kidderminster, Bewdley or Bridgnorth and let the train take the strain! Or travel to Highley for The Engine House, where you can visit the exhibition, the gift-shop and perhaps enjoy a meal in the comfort of our restaurant, that overlooks the Severn Valley and the Railway.

Compare the cost of a relaxing journey by train along the beautiful Severn Valley with the cost of taxi and bus fares, fuel and parking charges.

Trains operate most weekends and daily during the summer months. There is also a daily service during all main school holidays. The Engine House is open on the same dates. Please refer to the current timetable brochure for full details.

## The Engine House – Annual Pass

Local residents may also purchase an Engine House Annual Pass. This pass permits an unlimited number of admissions to The Engine House for 12 months for up to four persons. The Engine House Annual Pass costs £32 per household and may be purchased directly at The Engine House admission desk. The cost of rail travel is not included in this offer.

The Local Residents Railcard and The Engine House Annual Pass are available to residents in the following postcode areas:

**DY10, DY11, DY12, DY13, DY14, WV15 & WV16**

## Conditions Of Use Local Residents Railcard

Each railcard or pass consists of two portions:

An Identity Card which includes a photograph of the holder and his/her signature.

An authority card, which must be renewed annually on payment of the appropriate fee.

Each Local Residents Railcard entitles the holder, together with one other person (adult or child) to travel on SVR scheduled trains at the child rate (Don't forget that under 4's travel free) and receive concessionary admission to The Engine House, where applicable.

Local Residents Railcards are NOT valid for travel or concessionary Engine House admission, on 'Santa Specials', fare-inclusive dining trains, charter trains and any other trains that do not appear in the SVR's public timetable. They are not valid on dates marked as 'Special Events' in our published calendar.

The Local Residents Railcard must be produced when tickets are purchased either at one of our stations or at The Engine House admission desk. The Company will not issue refunds against tickets that have been purchased at the full price as a result of the Railcard not being produced when tickets were purchased.

Local Residents Railcards remain the property of Severn Valley Railway (Holdings) PLC and may be withdrawn at the Company's discretion.

## The Engine House Annual Pass

This pass may be purchased from The Engine House admission desk only. It is valid for 12 months from the date of issue and entitles up to four people free admission to The Engine House. The cost of rail travel, concessionary or otherwise, is not included in this offer.

Proof of eligibility in the form of two utility bills or a current Local Residents Railcard will be required at the time of purchase, together with one passport style photograph.
